**MIZORAM POLICE MANUAL, 2005**

1. In Mizoram Police: who are Gazetted and Non-Gazetted officers? Who are Subordinate Officers and Under Officers? Are Constables Under Officers? (5)
2. What are the duties in which the Women Police will be generally utilised? (7)
3. What is a Good Service Mark and how is it awarded? What are the benefits of Good Service Mark? What is the effect of major punishment on the Good Service Marks at the credit of the officer? (8)
4. Write a brief note on Criminal Prosecution against a Police officer in relation to the provisions of Section 197 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973. (5)
5. State whether the followings are TRUE or FALSE: (5×1=5)
  - (a) The Superintendent of Police shall be competent to grant a reward up to Rs 1000/- and the Director General of Police up to Rs 5000/-
  - (b) A Black Mark is a major penalty.
  - (c) A Grade-III Driver with satisfactory service of 5 years as Driver shall be eligible for promotion to Grade-II Driver. A Grade-II Driver with 10 years of satisfactory service shall be eligible for promotion to Grade-I Driver.
  - (d) A Superintendent of Police is competent to establish a Beat Post within his district without approval of Police Headquarters.
  - (e) There is no distinction between Dismissal and Removal from service. Both have the same effect.

  - (c) Internal Security
  - (d) Organised Crime
  - (e) Service Companies
9. State *any four (4)* social responsibilities of the police. (4)

10. State whether the followings are TRUE or FALSE: (6×1= 6)
- (a) The Mizoram Police Act, 2011 has come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> of September, 2013.
  - (b) An order of suspension of a Police Officer shall be reviewed every 90 (ninety) days.
  - (c) The Indian Police Act, 1861 is still applicable in its entirety in Mizoram even after the coming into force of the Mizoram Police Act, 2011.
  - (d) There is no bar in appointing a serving government employee as an Independent Member of the State Security Commission.
  - (e) Director General of Police, without the approval of the State Government, can outsource as many non-core police functions as possible to enable police officers to concentrate on core police functions.
  - (f) No police officer shall engage in any other employment or office of profit whatsoever, other than his duties.
