 - (c) Borrowing by States
3. Describe the duties and functions of the Finance Commission. (10)

4. Write **R** for those activities performed by a government servant requiring permission/sanction of the prescribed authority and **NR** for those not requiring sanction of the prescribed authority: (10×1=10)
 - (i) To join educational institution or course of studies for University degree.
 - (ii) To publish a book himself or through a publisher in the bona fide discharge of his duties.
 - (iii) Giving evidence at any judicial enquiry.
 - (iv) To attend and speak at functions and ceremonies performed by others in respect of purely non-political or cultural institutions.
 - (v) To own wholly or in part or conduct or participate in editing or management of any newspaper or other periodical publication or electronic media.
 - (vi) Acceptance of a part-time lectureship in an educational institution which is in the nature of a regular remunerative occupation.
 - (vii) To participate in the fund raising efforts of the 'National Foundation for Communal Harmony'.
 - (viii) To undertake occasional work of a literary, artistic or scientific character.
 - (ix) To be members of or actively participate in the activities of Indo-Foreign Cultural Organization.
 - (x) To accept international awards.
