5. How would you regulate the pay of a Government servant where an order of penalty of his reduction to a lower service, grade or post is set aside or modified by a Competent Authority on appeal or review? (4)

6. On what grounds can an Appropriate Authority withhold permission to a Government servant who seeks to retire under FR 56 (k)(1)? (3)
