- (b) What is the amount of pension payable to a Government servant retiring-
- (i) before completing qualifying service of ten years
- (ii) after completing qualifying service of ten years.
- (c) What is meant by Enhanced rate of Family pension? How long can Family Pension be paid at this rate to the family of a deceased Government servant if he had died :
- (i) While in service.
- (ii) After retirement.
- (d) How will you reckon the service for the purpose of pension in the case of contract employee subsequently appointed in a pensionable post without interruption?
- (e) Mention the period for which Family Pension is payable to
- (i) widow/widower (ii) unmarried son
- (iii) widowed/divorced daughter (iv) parents
- (v) disabled siblings
- (f) What is the minimum length of service for a Government servant to elect for voluntary retirement? What is the procedure for such retirement?
- (g) What are the conditions under which Retirement/Death Gratuity lapses to the Government? What is the Certificate required to be produced to receive Gratuity in such cases?
2. What are the circumstances under which the President can withhold a pension or gratuity or withdraw a pension or part thereof and order recovery from pension or gratuity of any pecuniary loss caused to the Government? (4)
3. How are periods of suspension treated for calculating the pensionable service of an officer? (3)
4. Define the term 'Family' in relation to a Government servant for the purpose of Family Pension, 1972. (3)
