- 3. Mens rea is not an essential element in respect of five offenses in the Indian Penal Code. What are they? Elucidate.
- 4. Nothing is an offence which is done in the exercise of the right of private defence. Elaborate on this statement.
- 5. Is attempt to commit a crime punishable? Discuss the law under the provision of the Indian Penal Code.
- 6. Discuss the principle surrounding the Doctrine of Double Jeopardy as propounded in the maxim 'a man shall not be twice vexed for one and the same cause'.
- 7. Discuss the rights available to persons who are arrested for alleged commission of a crime.
- 8. What is First Information Report? Discuss the powers of the police in investigation of a crime.
- 9. Explain the powers of the Executive Magistrate as regards to the provisions of Section 144 of Criminal Procedure Code.
- 10. Bail is recognition of the presumption of innocence. Do you agree with this statement? Explain.
- 11. Discuss the importance of 'fact in issue' and 'relevant fact' as mentioned in the Indian Evidence Act, 1872.
- 12. Describe in detail the difference between primary and secondary evidence. Use illustrations if necessary.
- 13. What is confession? Explain the admissibility of confessions when received in evidence in criminal cases.
- 14. What is the rationale of making a dying declaration? Discuss the essential ingredients of a relevant dying declaration.
- 15. Is oral evidence admissible in court as against documentary evidence? Explain your answer with relevant case laws.

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
