The Mizoram Public Service Commission, constituted in pursuance of Article 315 of the Constitution of India has been functioning with its headquarter at Aizawl since the 1<sup>st</sup> May, 1991.

**1. THE COMMISSION AND ITS COMPOSITION :**

The composition of the Commission during the year under report was as follows :

**2. BUDGET ALLOCATION, RECEIPT & EXPENDITURE :**

During the Financial year 2021 - 2022, a provision of **Rs.847.74** lakh was allocated to the Mizoram Public Service Commission against which the Commission incurred an expenditure of **Rs.817.70** lakh. Further **Rs.9.06** lakh only was received by way of collection of examination fees and sales of application forms etc.

**3. FUNCTIONS :**

As per provisions under Article 320 of the Constitution of India, it is the duty of the Commission to conduct examinations for appointment to various services and posts in the State and to advise the Government on all matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services, and to give advice to the Government in any matter which the Governor may refer to the Commission, as well as principles to be followed in making such appointments, promotions and transfers from one service to another. The Commission is also to be consulted by the Government before taking final decision on disciplinary matters in respect of persons serving under the State Government in civil capacity. The Commission's advice is also to be sought regarding any claim filed by a Government servant for payment of legal expenses incurred by him / her in defending himself / herself in any legal proceedings instituted against him / her for acts done in the execution of his/



her duties as also on the award of compensation for injuries sustained by a Government servant in his / her civil capacity.

As per the provisions of the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1994, the Commission is to be consulted by the Government on the following matters:

- a) Appointment to a post carrying the scale of pay of RS. 2900.00 per month and above.
- b) Principles to be followed in making of promotions or on the suitability of candidates for promotion by the Governor.

However, the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitations of Functions) Regulations 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations) was amended by the Government from time to time, and the latest amendment in respect of Direct Recruitment was notified in the Mizoram Gazetted under Memo No. A. 12017/2/2003-P&AR (GSW) dt.17.06.2019. Thus, the existing Regulations under 3(a) were substituted and it shall not be necessary to consult the Commission when an appointment is to be made by the Governor or by any authority other than the Governor in respect of Group 'B'(Non-Gazetted), Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts. Proviso to this Regulations exempt the recruitment of all posts of Zoram Medical College from consultation with the Commission. Again, some provisions in the Principal Regulation were deleted and new provisions were inserted in this amendment Regulations.

Again, by virtue of the provisions of the Office Memorandum issued by the State Government in the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms (General Service Wing) vide No.A.31011/1/2019 -P&AR(GSW) dated 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2019, it became the duty of the Commission to give advice on the matter of confirmation to service, or extension of probation period to a person on probation whose recruitment were under the purview of the Commission.

The works of the Commission for the period under report could be summarised as under:

- 1) Recruitment to the service or post of all Gazetted posts under the State Government.
- 2) Promotion from lower post to higher post/grade, including through Limited Departmental Examination of all Gazetted posts under the State Government.
- 3) To give advice in all matters relating to the method of recruitment and on the principles to be followed in making appointment to all Gazetted posts under the State Government.
- 4) To give advice on disciplinary cases.



- 5) To give advice on the matter of confirmation to service, or extension of probation period to a person on probation whose recruitment were under the purview of the Commission.
- 6) Any claim payable out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to a person serving under the Government in a civil capacity towards the cost incurred by him/her in defending legal proceedings instituted against him/her for acts done or purported to have been done in execution of his/her duty.
- 7) Any claim for the award of a pension in respect of injuries sustained by a person while serving under the State Government, in a civil capacity and any question as to the amount of any such award.

**INTRODUCTION OF VIDEO INTERVIEW SYSTEM AND EXAMINATION AND STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE**

Due to prevailing Covid pandemic, it became necessary to follow Standard Operating Procedure(SOP) issued by the Government and the social distancing norms and Covid Appropriate Behaviour(CAB) issued by the Commission itself. An off-line Video Interview System was devised with advanced and latest available electronic tools and devices in compliance to CAB. The first video interview was smoothly conducted on 05.08.2020. In



the reported period, 13 such interviews were conducted successfully. A system of Standard Operating Procedure for written examination was also prepared in line with the safety norms issued by the Authority.

**II. PROMOTION, REGULARIZATION, ABSORPTION AND CONFIRMATION:**

The Commission received various proposals for filling up of vacant posts by Promotion/Absorption/Regularization and Confirmation of a person on probation from different departments of the State Government. The Commission held 228 sittings to deliberate these proposals and made suitable recommendations.

**III. DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATIONS :**

As per the provisions laid down in the respective Service Rules/Recruitment Rules, or the Departmental Examination Regulation for certain services and posts under the Government, departmental examinations were required for promotion to higher grade/post or for confirmation to a service 4 (four) such examinations were conducted during the year under report.

**IV. LIMITED DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATIONS :**

The Commission received proposals from various Government's Departments to conduct Limited Departmental Examinations for making promotions. Accordingly, 5 (five) Limited Departmental Examinations were conducted during the period and on the basis of the results the Commission made recommendations to the respective Departments.

**V. RECRUITMENT RULES & SERVICE RULES :**

During the period under report there were 9 (nine) referred cases regarding framing and amendment of various Recruitment Rules/Service Rules from the Government for vetting. All the cases were examined and the comments of the Commission were conveyed.

**VI. THE COMMISSION'S SECRETARIAT :**

**5. CONSULTATION OF THE COMMISSION ON IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES ON GOVERNMENT SERVANTS :**

As enumerated in sub clause 'c' of clause 3 of Article 320 of the Constitution of India, the Commission is to be consulted in matters regarding imposition of penalties on Government servants. During the period under report, the Commission has received one instance and it was disposed instantly.

**6. APPOINTMENT MADE WITHOUT CONSULTATION OF THE COMMISSION :**

There were no instance of regular appointment made without consulting the Commission during the period under report.

**7. COURT CASE :**

The decisions of the Commission were challenged in the Hon'ble High Court on 7 (seven) occasions during the period under report and one case was finalised in favour of the Commission.

**8. RECRUITMENT SYSTEM :**

The method of recruitment, eligibility criteria and other conditions are generally provided in the Recruitment Rules or Regulations. In addition to these rules and regulations, the Commission devised and compiled its own Guidelines called The Mizoram Public Service Commission(Conduct Of Examinations) Guidelines; in consonance with these statutory rules and regulations; for fair and objective assessment of candidate's suitability for selection by way of recruitment through written examination and interview, recruitment by screening and interview and recruitment by personal interview only. The criteria, procedure and methods of selections are constantly reviewed and amended and incorporated in the Guidelines.

**9. WORKS THROUGH RTI ACT :**

The Commission, being a Public Authority, is accountable to RTI Act, 2005. In the reported period, 90 applications, seeking various information were received and were disposed within the prescribed time by the SPIO. There were no case of appeal either to the Departmental Appellate Authority or State Information Commission. A sum of **Rs.900.00** in the form of application fees and a sum of **RS.1400.00** as cost of documents was collected in the year of report.

NOTIFICATION

No.A. 12017/2/91 - P&AR(GSW) : In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Regulations as respects to services and posts in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram, specifying matters in which it shall not be necessary for the Mizoram Public Service Commission to be consulted.

- Short title and commencement* 1. (a) These Regulations may be called the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitations of Functions) Regulations, 1994.  
(b) They shall come into force at once.
- Definitions* 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires :-  
(i) "Appointing authority" means the authority which makes the appointments to any service or post in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram;  
(ii) "Commission" means the Mizoram Public Service Commission;  
(iii) "Constitution" means the Constitution of India;  
(iv) "Governor" means the Governor of Mizoram  
(v) "Service" or "Post" means civil service or post in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram.
- Limitation of functions in matters relating to methods of recruitment* 3. It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be consulted in matters relating to methods of recruitment to civil services and posts or the suitability of the candidates for such appointments, in the following cases, namely  
(a) When an appointment is to be made by the Governor or by recruitment an authority other than Governor to a post on a scale of pay the maximum of which is less than ₹. 2900/- per month.



- (A) When it is proposed to appoint a member of a service to a post, for appointment to which the rules of any other service makes a member of other service eligible, and which in the opinion of the Governor, is normally filled by a member of that service or is similar to posts normally filled by a member of that service.

### ILLUSTRATION

The appointment of an Officer of the Mizoram Civil Service to the following posts does not require consultation with the Commission : Posts of Deputy Commissioner, Joint Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Under Secretary or Officer on Special Duty in the Secretariat.

- (c) Appointment of the personal staff of the Governor and to his Secretariat.
- (d) Appointment of Law Officers of the State except the members of the State Judicial Service and the Gauhati High Court of Judicature.
- (e) When an officiating appointment is to be made by direct recruitment to a permanent post, if it is necessary in the Public interest that the appointment should be made immediately and a reference to the Commission would cause undue delay :

Provided that, if the vacancy, actual or probable, is for a period of six months or more, the Commission shall, as soon as possible, be consulted in all matters mentioned in clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution but not later than the 30th day from the date of issue of such appointment orders.

- (f) When an appointment is to be made by direct recruitment to a temporary post, if it is necessary in the public interest that the appointment should be made immediately and a reference to the Commission would cause undue delay :

Provided that if the temporary post has been sanctioned or, is likely to last more than six months, the Commission shall, as soon as possible, be consulted in all matters mentioned in clause (3) of the Article 320 of the Constitution but not later than the 30th day from date of issue of such appointment orders.

- (g) When it is proposed to re-appoint a retired servant of the Government of India or State Government temporarily to (i) a permanent post created in addition to the Cadre of the service from which he retired or (ii) a temporary post created as addition to the Cadre of the service from which he retired or (iii) any other temporary post the duties of which are similar to those normally discharged by members of that service:
- (h) When it is proposed to appoint temporarily an Officer of the Indian Armed Forces to a Civil post or service for a period not exceeding three years;



- (i) When it is proposed to make appointment to a post on a contract basis for a period not exceeding three years;

Provided that in case the appointment on a contract basis is likely to exceed a period of three years, the Commission shall be consulted before the contract is renewed or extended;

- (j) When it is proposed to make any appointment to an honorary post.

*Limitation of functions in respect of promotion*

4. It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission on the principles to be followed in making promotions or on the suitability of candidates for promotion in the following cases:-

- (a) Promotion to a service by an authority other than the Governor;
- (b) Promotion from a lower to a higher grade or post within the time scale of pay provided in the Rules unless the promotion is to be made by selection;
- (c) Officiating promotion for a period which is not likely to last for more than one year;

Provided that if the period of officiating promotion is extended beyond the term for which it was originally sanctioned, the period of promotion shall, for purpose of this regulation, be reckoned from the date when the promotion originally took effect and not from the date of the extension of the period.

*Limitation of functions in respect of transfer*

5. It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission on the principles to be followed in making transfer or on the suitability of candidates for transfer from one post to another in the same service.

*Limitation of functions in respect of disciplinary cases*

6. It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be consulted in disciplinary matters in the following cases :-

- (a) in passing an order by any authority other than Governor, whether the order passed is an original, an appellate or a revisionary order;
- (b) by the Governor, when rejecting a petition or memorial;
- (c) in any case in which the Commission has at any previous stage been consulted as to the order to be passed and no fresh question has thereafter arisen for determination.

**ILLUSTRATIONS**

- (a) The stoppage of an officer appointed by the Governor at an efficiency bar does not require consultation with the Commission.
- (b) an officer is censured by the Governor. It is not necessary to consult Commission before the order of censure is passed;
- (c) an officer is suspended pending an enquiry into his conduct. The Commission need not be consulted before the order of suspension is passed;
- (d) it is proposed to dismiss a State Service Officer or to reduce his pension. The Commission must be consulted before an order is passed by the Governor;
- (e) It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission in any case relating to:
  - (i) the termination of probation of any person;
  - (ii) the discharge of reversion of a person otherwise than as penalty;
  - (iii) the termination of the employment of a person in accordance with the terms of his contract or employment;
  - (iv) the imposition of any penalty laid down in any rule or order for failure to pass any test or examination within a specified time;
- (f) Reduction in pension in a disciplinary case. The pension of an official is reduced by the Head of Department. The appeal is filed before the Governor. The Commission should be consulted before the appeal is disposed of by Governor;
- (g) An Assistant in a District Office is dismissed by the District Officer. He appeals to the Governor. The Commission will be consulted before an order is passed by the Governor.
- (h) An official in a subordinate service is dismissed by the Head of Department. An appeal made to the Governor. It is not necessary for the Head of Department to consult the Commission before dismissing the official. But the Commission should be consulted by the Governor before deciding the appeal;



- (i) An Officer who was dismissed by an original order of the Governor memorializes the Governor against that order. The Commission need not be consulted on the memorial if the order of dismissal was after consulting the Commission.
  - (j) An official was dismissed on his appeal rejected by an authority Subordinate to the Governor. He memorializes the Governor against that order. The Commission must be consulted before the Governor re-instates him but not if the Governor decides to reject his memorial.
7. All previous Regulation made on the subject shall stand repealed on and from the date of the commencement of this Regulation;

Provided that any action or actions taken under such Regulations hereby repealed shall be deemed to have been taken under these Regulations.

3. The existing provision under Rule 4 (b) relating to Limitation of Functions in respect of promotion, shall be substituted by the following :-

“promotion from a lower to higher grade or posts in respect of all Non-Gazetted posts.”

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules for regulating the recruitment of employees on Contract basis under the Government of Mizoram, namely :

1. **Short Title & Commencement**

- (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Group 'A' and 'B' posts Recruitment (on Contract Basis) Rules, 2013
- (2) These rules shall come into force with immediate effect

2. **Application**

- (1) These Rules shall apply to all recruitment on Contract basis for Group 'A' and 'B' posts under the Government of Mizoram
- (2) These Rules shall not be applicable to recruitment under Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS), Co-terminus post(s) and re-employment of pensioners on Contract basis.

3. **Recruitment on Contract Basis**

- (1) Recruitment on Contract basis for Group 'A' and 'B' post(s) under the Government of Mizoram against sanctioned post(s) which are likely to last for more than 3 years shall be made through the Mizoram Public Service Commission as per the Recruitment Rules in force for such post(s)
- (2) Recruitment on Contract basis for Group 'A' and 'B' post(s) under the Government



of Mizoram shall be made within the direct recruitment quota in the Recruitment Rules in force for such post(s)

4. **Regularisation of Contract basis**

- (1) Regularisation of employees recruited by Mizoram Public Service Commission on Contract basis for Group 'A' and 'B' post(s) under the Government of Mizoram shall be done under the "Government of Mizoram Regularisation of Contract Employees Scheme, 2008" as amended from time to time
- (2) Contract employees for Group 'A' and 'B' post(s) under the Government of Mizoram which are not recruited through Mizoram Public Service Commission after the commencement of these Rules shall not be entitled to regularisation under the "Government of Mizoram Regularisation of Contract Employees Scheme, 2008" as amended from time to time.
- (3) All recruitments on Contract basis which were recommended by the duly authorized Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee with prior approval of Personnel & Administrative Reforms Department and Finance Department prior to the commencement of these rules shall be treated as valid recruitment for the purpose of regularisation of Contract employees under the "Government of Mizoram Regularisation of Contract Employees Scheme, 2008" as amended from time to time

5. **Power to relax**

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Mizoram Public Service Commission, relax any of the provision of these rules.

6. **Repeal**

The Selection Committee constituted by the Government of Mizoram for engagement of Group 'A' and 'B' posts on contract vide Notification No.A.41012/1/2003-P&AR(GSW) dated 19.07.2010 shall stand repealed on and from the date of commencement of these Rules.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to clause (3) of article 320 of the Constitution, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following regulations further to amend the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1994 specifying matters in which it shall not be necessary for the Mizoram Public Service Commission to be consulted, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement:**

- 1) These regulations may be called the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019
- 2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Amendment of regulation 3 :**

- 1) In the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations), entries in clause (a) of regulation (3) shall be substituted as follows, namely:

"(a) Appointment through direct recruitment by the Governor or by an authority other than the Governor in respect of Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted), Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts.

Provided that the recruitment of all posts for the establishment of Zoram Medical College shall stand exempted from consultation with the Commission"

- 2) Clause (f) of regulation (3) of the Principal Regulations shall be deleted.
- 3) After clause (j) of regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations, new clauses (k), (l) and (m) shall be inserted as follows, namely:
  - "(k) Appointment through deputation by the Governor or by an authority other than the Governor in respect of Group 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D' posts save as otherwise expressly provided in the recruitment rules
  - (l) Appointment through absorption by the Governor or by an authority other than the Governor in respect of Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted), Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts save as otherwise expressly provided in the recruitment rules
  - (m) Appointment through regularisation of Contract/Work-charged/Muster Roll/officiating or ad hoc employees by the Governor or by an authority other than the Governor in

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respect of Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted), Group 'C' and 'D' posts save as otherwise expressly provided in the recruitment rules"

3. . **Amendment of regulation 4** :- After clause (c) of regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations, a new clause (d) shall be inserted as follows, namely:  
"(d) Promotion through limited departmental examination from a lower to a higher post/grade to Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted) posts and below"
4. **Amendment of regulation 6** :- After regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations, new regulations viz. 6A and 6B shall be inserted as follows, namely:  
"6A. It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission in regard to any claim by or in respect of a person who is serving or has served under the State Government in a civil capacity, that any costs incurred by him in defending legal proceedings instituted against him in respect of acts done or purporting to be done in the execution of his duty should be paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State as mentioned in sub-clause (d) of clause (3) of article 320 of the Constitution:  
a) In the case of person belonging to Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted), Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts  
b) In any other case, where the Government accepted the claim of the person"
- 6B. It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission on any claim for the award of a pension in respect of injuries sustained by a person while serving under the State Government in a civil capacity, and any question as to the amount of any such award as mentioned in sub-clause (e) of clause (3) of article 320 of the Constitution:  
a) In the case of person belonging to Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted), Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts"
