### 2. RECEIPT & EXPENDITURE:

During the Financial year 2011 - 2012, a provision of ₹416.86 lakhs was allocated to the Mizoram Public Service Commission and the Commission incurred an expenditure of ₹398.65 lakhs. ₹5.94 lakhs only was received by way of collection of Examination fees and sale of application forms etc.

### 3. FUNCTIONS:

In accordance with Article 320 of the Constitution of India, it is the duty of the Commission to conduct Examinations for appointment to various services in the State and to advise the Government on all matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services, principles to be followed in making such appointments, promotions and transfers from one service to another. The Commission is also to be consulted by the Government before taking final decision on disciplinary matters in respect of persons serving under the State Government in a civil capacity.

The Commission's advice is also to be sought regarding any claim filed by a Government servant for payment of legal expenses incurred by him/her in defending himself/herself in any legal proceedings instituted against him/her for acts done in the execution of his/her duties as also on the award of compensation for injuries sustained by a Government servant in his/her civil capacity.

As per the provisions of the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1994, the Commission is to be consulted by the Government in the following matters:

- a) Appointment to a post carrying the scale of pay, the maximum of which is not less than ₹ 9000.00 per month.
- b) Principles to be followed in making promotions or on the suitability of candidates for appointment to a post carrying the maximum scale of pay which is not less than ₹ 9000.00 per month.

However, the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations 1994 were amended by the the Govt. of Mizoram and notified in the Mizoram Gazette under Memo No. A. 12017/2/2003-P&AR (GSW) dt. 26.05.2011. Thus, the existing provisions under 3(a) were substituted and it shall not be necessary to consult the Commission when an appointment is to be made by the Governor or by any authority other than the Governor in respect of all posts carrying a grade pay of ₹ 4400/pm and below for all direct recruitments. Consequently, the existing regulation 4(b) was substituted and it shall not be necessary to consult the Commission regarding promotion from a lower to a higher grade or post in respect of all posts carrying a grade pay of ₹ 4400/- pm and below. Details may be seen at Appendix - I, II,II(A), II(B), II(C), II(D), II(E), II(F), II(G), II(H) and II(I).

### 4. ACHIEVEMENT:

i) <u>DIRECT RECRUITMENT</u>: During the period under report the Commission was consulted in matters of recruitment etc. as indicated below:

The Commission conducted Written Examinations on seven occasions and details may be seen at Appendix - II(H). All the **41** candidates recommended by the Commission, were given appointments. Details may be seen at Appendix - II(I).

### ii) PROMOTIONS:

The Commission received 133 proposals for filling up 528 vacant posts by promotion under various Departments. The Commission held 133 meetings to consider promotions and accordingly made suitable recommendation. Details may be seen at Appendix - III.

### iii) DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATIONS:

In accordance with the Mizoram Civil Service (Departmental Examination) Regulations, 1991, the Mizoram Public Service Commission is entrusted to conduct Departmental Examinations for Mizoram Civil Service (Probationers). Accordingly Departmental Examination for the Junior Grade of Mizoram Civil Service (Probationers) was conducted from

25.07.2011 to 28.07.2011 and 23 (twenty-three) Probationers appeared in the Examination. On the basis of the result of this examination combined with the result of the examination held earlier, 6 (Six) Probationers are declared to have cleared the Departmental Examination.

Departmental Examination for Junior Grade of Mizoram Police Service (Probationers) was conducted from 25.07.2011 to 29.07.2011 and 21 (twenty-one) Probationers appeared in the examination. On the basis of the result of this examination combined with the result of the examination held earlier, 5 (five) Probationers are declared to have cleared the Departmental Examination.

Departmental Examination for Junior Grade of Mizoram Finance & Accounts Service (Probationers) was also conducted from 25.07.2011 to 01.08.2011 and 8 (eight) Probationers appeared in the examination. Based on the result of this examination combined with the result of the examination held earlier, 1 (One) Probationer is declared to have cleared the Departmental Examination.

### iv) LIMITED DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION

The Commission received a requisition for the conduct of Limited Departmental Examinations for making promotion under various Departments of the Government of Mizoram. Details may be seen at Appendix - IV.

### v) RECRUITMENT RULES & SERVICE RULES:

During the period under report 43 references were received regarding framing and amendment of various Recruitment Rules/Service Rules. All cases were examined and advice of the Commission was conveyed to the Government. Details may be seen at Appendix - V.

# 5. <u>CONSULTATION OF THE COMMISSION ON IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES ON GOVERNMENT SERVANTS</u>:

As enumerated in sub Clause 'C' of Clause 3 of Article 320 of the Constitution of India, the Commission is to be consulted in matters regarding imposition of penalties on Government servants. During the period under report, the Commission was consulted on four occasions and the Commission after examining the cases conveyed its views on all the cases to the Government.

## 6. <u>APPOINTMENT MADE WITHOUT CONSULTATION</u> OF THE COMMISSION:

No instances have been found where regular appointments are made without consulting the Commission during the period under report.

#### 7. COURT CASES:

The decisions of the Commission were challenged in the Hon'ble High Court on six occassions during the period under report and all the cases were finalised in favour of the Commission.

The Commission, since its inception made every 8. effort for timely disposal of cases relating to direct recruitment by means of Competitive Examination and Promotion by Departmental Promotion Committee. However, some Departments submitted incomplete proposals and furnished the requisite documents in resulted in piece-meal. This unnecessary correspondences and delay in disposal of promotion cases. It is desirable that all the concerned Departments submit their proposals complete in all respects so as to enable Commission to dispose of the proposals expeditiously.

#### EXAMINATION SYSTEM :

The efficiency of the Government generally depends on the quality of the personnel selected and the Commission has been striving to ensure selection of persons of high calibre through a fair and objective selection process. The criteria, procedure and methods of selections are constantly reviewed for securing the best talents available for the State of Mizoram.

In consultation with the Mizoram Public Service Commission, the Government of Mizoram introduced Combined Competitive Examination for Mizoram Civil Service (MCS), Mizoram Police Service (MPS), Mizoram Finance & Account Service (MF&AS) and Mizoram Information Service (MIS) and notified the Mizoram Civil Services (Combined Competitive Examination) Regulations, 2011 in the official Gazette vide No. A.45011/1/2010-P&AR(GSW) dated 09.02.2012.

### 10. EXAMINATION HALL:

Construction of Examination Hall of the Commission is in progress and is expected to be completed by the end of 2013.

The Examination Hall which is under construction near the office of the Mizoram Public Service Commission will be able to accommodate about 1200 candidates for written Examinations and the Government of Mizoram was approached to allot suitable plot of land within the New Secretariat Complex at Khatla for construction of additional building for use as Examination Hall. In view of the urgent need of the Mizoram Public Service Commission, the Government allotted a plot of land adjoining the land allotted to the Health & Family Welfare Department for construction of additional Examination Hall vide order No.D.21020/1/.06-GAD/pt.11/176 dated 16th August, 2011. When the

additional building for Examination Hall is constructed, it will be used not only by the Commission but also by other Departments under the Government of Mizoram, including Union Public Service Commission for conducting various Examinations. The Commission is grateful to the Government for allotment of the land.



# VISITS OF CHAIRMAN & MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION TO OTHER PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSIONS

During the year under report, Shri Vanengmawia (IAS Retd.), Chairman visited the Meghalaya Public Service Commission and attended 2nd Regional Conference of Chairpersons and Members of Public Service Commission held on 14 to 17.09.2011 at Shillong. #### NOTIFICATION

NO.A. 12017/2/91 - P&AR(GSW): In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Regulations as respects to services and posts in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram, specifying matters in which it shall not be necessary for the Mizoram Public Service Commission to be consulted.

Short title and comm-

1.

- (a) These Regulations may be called the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitations of Functions) Regulations, 1994.
- (b) They shall come into force at once.
- Definitions 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:-
  - (i) "Appointing authority" means the authority which makes the appointments to any service or post in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram;
  - (ii) "Commission" means the Mizoram Public Service Commission;

- (iii) "Constitution" means the Constitution of India;
- (iv) "Governor" means the Governor of Mizoram
- (v) "Service" or "Post" means civil service or post in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram.

Limitation, of functions in matters relating to methods of recruitment 3.

- It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be consulted in matters relating to methods of recruitment to civil services and posts or the suitability of the candidates for such appointments, in the following cases, namely
- (a) When an appointment is to be made by the Governor or by recruitment an authority other than Governor to a post on a scale of pay the maximum of which is less than Rs. 2900/- per month.
- (b) When it is proposed to appoint a member of a service to a post, for appointment to which the rules of any other service makes a member of other service eligible, and which in the opinion of the Governor, is normally filled by a member of that service or is similar to posts normally filled by a member of that service.

### ILLUSTRATION

The appointment of an Officer of the Mizoram Civil Service to the following posts does not require consultation with the Commission: Posts of Deputy Commissioner, Joint Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Under Secretary or Officer on Special Duty in the Secretariat.

- (c) Appointment of the personal staff of the Governor and to his Secretariat.
- (d) Appointment of Law Officers of the State except the members of the State Judicial Service and the Gauhati High Court of Judicature.
- (e) When an officiating appointment is to be made by direct recruitment to a permanent post, if it is necessary in the Public interest that the appointment should be made immediately and a reference to the Commission would cause undue delay:

Provided that, if the vacancy, actual or probable, is for a period of six months or more, the Commission shall, as soon as possible, be consulted in all matters mentioned in clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution but not later than the 30th day from the date of issue of such appointment orders.

(f) When an appointment is to be made by direct recruitment to a temporary post, if it is necessary in the public interest that the appointment should be made immediately and a reference to the Commission would cause undue delay:

Provided that if the temporary post has been sanctioned or, is likely to last more than six months, the Commission shall, as soon as possible, be consulted in all matters mentioned in clause (3) of the Article 320 of the Constitution but not later than the 30th day from date of issue of such appointment orders.

(g) When it is proposed to re-appoint a retired servant of the Government of India or State Government temporarily to (i) a permanent post created in addition to the Cadre of the service from which he retired or (ii) a temporary post created as addition to the Cadre of the service from which he retired or (iii) any other temporary post the duties of which are similar to those normally discharged by members of that service:

- (h) When it is proposed to appoint temporarily an Officer of the Indian Armed Forces to a Civil post or service for a period not exceeding three years;
- (i) When it is proposed to make appointment to a post on a contract basis for a period not exceeding three years;

Provided that in case the appointment on a contract basis is likely to exceed a period of three years, the Commission shall be consulted before the contract is renewed or extended;

(j) When it is proposed to make any appointment to an honorary post.

Limitation of function in respect of promotion.

- 4. It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission on the principles to be followed in making promotions or on the suitability of candidates for promotion in the following cases:-
- (a) Promotion to a service by an authority other than the Governor;
- (b) Promotion from a lower to a higher grade or post within the time scale of pay provided in the Rules unless the promotion is to be made by selection;
- (c) Officiating promotion for a period which is not likely to last for more than one year;

Provided that if the period of officiating promotion is extended beyond the term for which it was originally sanctioned, the period of promotion shall, for purpose of this regulation, be reckoned from the date when the promotion originally took effect and not from the date of the extension of the period.

Limitation of function in respect of transfer 5. It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission on the principles to be followed in making transfer or on the suitability of candidates for transfer from one post to another in the same service.

Limitation of function in respect of disciplinary

cases

 It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be consulted in disciplinary matters in the following cases:-

- (a) in passing an order by any authority other than Governor, whether the order passed is an original, an appellate or a revisionary order;
- (b) by the Governor, when rejecting a petition or memorial;
- (c) in any case in which the Commission has at any previous stage been consulted as to the order to be passed and no fresh question has thereafter arisen for determination.

### **ILLUSTRATIONS**

- (a) The stoppage of an officer appointed by the Governor at an efficiency bar does not require consultation with the Commission.
- (b) an officer is censured by the Governor. It is not necessary to consult Commission before the order of censure is passed;
- (c) an officer is suspended pending an enquiry into his conduct. The Commission need not be consulted before the order of suspension is passed;
- (d) it is proposed to dismiss a State Service Officer or to reduce his pension. The Commission must be consulted before an order is passed by the Governor:

- (e) it shall not be necessary to consult the Commissionin any case relating to:
  - (i) the termination of probation of any person;
  - (ii) the discharge of reversion of a person otherwise than as penalty;
  - (iii) the termination of the employment of a person in accordance with the terms of his contract or employment;
  - (iv) the imposition of any penalty laid down in any rule or order for failure to pass any test or examination within a specified time;
- (f) Reduction in pension in a disciplinary case. The pension of an official is reduced by the Head of Department. The appeal is filled before the Governor. The Commission should be con sulted before the appeal is disposed of by Governor;
- (g) An Assistant in a District Office is dismissed by the District Officer. He appeals to the Governor. The Commission will be consulted before an order is passed by the Governor.
- (h) An official in a subordinate service is dismissed by the Head of Department. An appeal made to the Governor. It is not necessary for the Head of Department to consult the Commission before dismissing the official. But the Commission should be consulted by the Governor before deciding the appeal;
- (i) An Officer who was dismisse by an original order of the Governor memorializes the Governor against that order. The Commission need not be consulted on the memorial if the order of dismissal was after consulting the Commission.

(j) An official was dismissed on his appeal rejected by an authority Subordinate to the Governor. He memoralizes the Governor against that order. The Commission must be consulted before the Governor re-instates him but not if the Governor decides to reject his memorial.

Repeal saving

7.

All previous Regulation made on the subject shall stand repealed on and from the date of the commencement of this Regulation;

Provided that any action or actions taken under such Regulations hereby repealed shall be deemed to have been taken under these Regulations.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of Article 1318 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Regulations to further amend the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Conditions of Service) Regulations, 1994 (hereinafter called "Principal Regulation") published vide Notification No.A.12017/2/91-PAR (GS), dated 4.1.95 in the Mizoram Gazette Vol.No.XIV Extra ordinary Issue No.1 dated 5.1.1995.

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) These Rules may be called of Mizoram Public Service Commission (Conditions of Service) (Sixth Amendment) Regulations, 2006.
  - (2) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

Amendment of Regulation 9(A)

The existing provision under part IV Regulation 9(A) of the Principal Regulations relating to Pension and other Retirement benefits shall be substituted as follows:-

"The Chairman or the Member of the Mizoram Public Service Commission who, at the date of his appointment as such, was in the service of the Government of Mizoram or of any State Government as an all India Service Officers or State Service Officers may be permitted to elect to draw his pension and other retirement benefits admissible to him under the All India Service (Death-Cum-Retirement Benefits) Rules, 1958 or CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 or elect to count his service in the Commission as Qualifying Service for the purpose of Pension under all India Service (Death-Cum-Retirement Benefits) Rules, 1958 or CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972, as the case may be."

Provided that if the Chairman or Member has opted to count his service in the Commission as Qualifying Service for the purpose of pension under CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972, his pension will be calculated based on the last pay drawn by him as the Chairman or Member of the Commission as the case may be.
