1. THE COMMISSION AND ITS COMPOSITION :

The composition of the Commission during the year under report was as follows:

2. BUDGET ALLOCATION, RECEIPT & EXPENDITURE :

During the Financial year 2016 - 2017, a provision of ₹ 613.39 lakh was allocated to the Mizoram Public Service Commission and the Commission incurred an expenditure of ₹ 541.85 lakh and ₹ 21.50 lakh only was received by way of collection of Examination fees and sales of application forms etc.

3. FUNCTIONS :

In accordance with Article 320 of the Constitution of India, it is the duty of the Commission to conduct Examinations for appointment to various services and posts in the State and to advise the Government on all matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services, and to give advice the Government in any matter which the Governor refer to the Commission. Principles to be followed in making such appointments, promotions and transfers from one service to another. The Commission is also to be consulted by the Government before taking final decision on disciplinary matters in respect of persons serving under the State Government in civil capacity. The Commission's advice is also to be sought regarding any claim filed by a Government servant for payment of legal expenses incurred by him / her in defending himself / herself in any legal proceedings instituted against him / her for acts done in the execution of his/ her duties as also on the award of compensation for injuries sustained by a Government servant in his / her civil capacity.

As per the provisions of the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1994, the Commission is to be consulted by the Government on the following matters:

- a) Appointment to a post carrying the scale of pay of ₹ 2900.00 per month and above.
- b) Principles to be followed in making of promotions or on the suitability of candidates for promotion by the Governor.

However, the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations) was amended by the Government from time to time, the latest amendment in respect of direct recruitment was notified in the Mizoram Gazette under Memo No. A. 12017/2/91-P&AR (GSW) dt.30.07.2013. Thus, the existing Regulation under 3(a) were substituted and it shall not be necessary to consult the Commission when an appointment is to be made by the Governor or by any authority other than the Governor in respect of all posts carrying a grade pay of below ₹ 4200/- pm through direct recruitments. Consequently, the existing regulation 4(b) was substituted and hence it shall not be necessary to consult the Commission regarding promotion from a lower to a higher grade or post in respect of all posts carrying a grade pay of ₹ 4200/- pm and below. After this, further amendment was made by the Govt. and it was notified in the Mizoram Gazette vide Memo No. A.12017/2/91-P&AR(GSW) dt.28th May, 2014, and with this the existing regulation 4(b) was substituted and hence it shall not be necessary to consult the Commission regarding promotion from a lower to a higher grade or post in respect of all post of Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted) and below.

Again the Government of Mizoram, by Gazette Notification under Memo No. A.32012/1/2011-DP&AR/pt dt. 15.1.2014 entrusted the Commission for recruitment of Group A and B posts on Contract Basis and its subsequent Regularization.

4. ACHIEVEMENT :

I DIRECT RECRUITMENT : During the period under report, the Commission was consulted on matters of recruitment etc. as indicated below :

II. PROMOTION :

The Commission received 201 proposals for filling up 459 vacant posts by promotion/contract regularisation/absorption etc. under various Departments. The Commission held 201 sittings to consider promotions/regularisation/absorption etc. and accordingly made suitable recommendations.

III. DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATIONS :

As per the provisions laid down in the respective Service Rules/Recruitment Rules Departmental Examination Regulation for various posts of the Government, departmental examinations required for promotion to higher grade/post have been conducted on various occasions during the year under report.

IV. LIMITED DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATIONS :

The Commission received proposals from various Govt.'s Departments to conduct Limited Departmental Examinations for making promotions. Accordingly, Limited Departmental Examinations was conducted on various occasions during the period under report and on the basis of the results the Commission made recommendations to the respective Departments.

V. RECRUITMENT RULES & SERVICE RULES :

During the period under report there were 39 (thirty nine) referred cases regarding framing, amendment and relaxation of various Recruitment Rules/Service Rules from the Government. All the cases were examined and the comments of the Commission were conveyed to the Government accordingly.

VI. REGULARIZATION OF CONTRACTUAL & MUSTER ROLL EMPLOYEES:

During the year under report 60 Contractual and 7 Muster Roll employees under various Departments were recommended for regularization of their mode of engagement as per the respective Regularisation Schemes in force.

VII. ABSORPTION OF CERTAIN POSTS INTO STATE GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT OR SERVICE

During the year under report the Commission accorded approval for absorption of certain posts from one department of the State Govt. or Autonomous District Council into certain departments of the State Govt.

VII. CONVERSION OF MODE OF ENGAGEMENT INTO OTHER MODE:

During the year under report the Commission accorded approval for conversion of Muster Roll and Officiating engagements/appointments into Contractual engagement.

5. CONSULTATION OF THE COMMISSION ON IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES ON GOVERNMENT SERVANTS :

As enumerated in sub Clause 'c' of Clause 3 of Article 320 of the Constitution of India, the Commission is to be consulted in matters regarding imposition of penalties on Government servants. During the period under report, the Commission was consulted on 11 (Eleven) cases and the Commission, after examining the cases conveyed its views on all the cases to the Government.

6. APPOINTMENT MADE WITHOUT CONSULTATION OF THE COMMISSION :

No instances have been found whereby regular appointments are made without consulting the Commission during the period under report.

7. COURT CASE :

The decisions of the Commission were challenged in the Hon'ble High Court on 9 (Nine) occasions during the period under report and the case were finalised in favour of the Commission.

8. CONCERN FOR IMPROVEMENT

The Commission, since its inception made every effort for timely disposal of cases relating to direct recruitment by means of Competitive Examination and Promotion by Departmental Promotion Committee. However, some Departments submitted incomplete proposals and furnished the requisite documents in a piece-meal manner. This resulted in unnecessary correspondences and delay in disposal of promotion cases. It is desirable that all the concerned Departments submit their proposals complete in all respects so as to enable Commission to dispose of the proposals expeditiously.

9. EXAMINATION SYSTEM :

The efficiency of the Government generally depends on the quality of the personnel selected for various posts. Therefore, the Commission has been striving to ensure selection of the most suitable persons through fair and objective selection process. The criteria, procedure and methods of selections are constantly reviewed for securing the best talents available for the State of Mizoram.

10. WORKS THROUGH RTI ACT :

With the introduction of Right to Information Act, 2005, the Mizoram Public Service Commission, being a public Authority, designated Departmental Appellate Authority, State Public Information Officer and State Assistant Public Information Officer in conformity with the Act. During the period under report, 105 Applications were received and were disposed within the prescribed time. A sum of ₹ 5867.00 had been collected by way of application fees and cost of documents. No appeal had been instituted against the Commission during the period under report

11. CONFERENCE ATTENDED BY MEMBER :

During the year under report, Rev. Zosangliana Colney, Hon'ble Member, attended the National Conference Meeting of State Public Service Commission held during 18-19.2.2017 at Gujarat.

12. NON ACCEPTANCE OF THE COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION AND CONNECTED MATTERS


The Commission is under Constitutional obligation to give its considered recommendation to the Government on all cases referred to it under Article 320. The Commission noticed with regret that its recommendation has, so far, not been accepted by the Government in the case of direct recruitment to the 25 (twenty five) posts of Staff Nurse under Health & Family Welfare Department.

NOTIFICATION

No.A. 12017/2/91 - P&AR(GSW) : In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Regulations as respects to services and posts in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram, specifying matters in which it shall not be necessary for the Mizoram Public Service Commission to be consulted.

- Short title and commencement* 1. (a) These Regulations may be called the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Limitations of Functions) Regulations, 1994.
(b) They shall come into force at once.
- Definitions* 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires :-
(i) "Appointing authority" means the authority which makes the appointments to any service or post in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram;
(ii) "Commission" means the Mizoram Public Service Commission;
(iii) "Constitution" means the Constitution of India;
(iv) "Governor" means the Governor of Mizoram
(v) "Service" or "Post" means civil service or post in connection with the affairs of the State of Mizoram.
- Limitation of functions in matters relating to methods of recruitment* 3. It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be consulted in matters relating to methods of recruitment to civil services and posts or the suitability of the candidates for such appointments, in the following cases, namely
(a) When an appointment is to be made by the Governor or by recruitment an authority other than Governor to a post on a scale of pay the maximum of which is less than ₹. 2900/- per month.

- (b) When it is proposed to appoint a member of a service to a post, for appointment to which the rules of any other service makes a member of other service eligible, and which in the opinion of the Governor, is normally filled by a member of that service or is similar to posts normally filled by a member of that service.

ILLUSTRATION

The appointment of an Officer of the Mizoram Civil Service to the following posts does not require consultation with the Commission : Posts of Deputy Commissioner, Joint Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Under Secretary or Officer on Special Duty in the Secretariat.

- (c) Appointment of the personal staff of the Governor and to his Secretariat.
- (d) Appointment of Law Officers of the State except the members of the State Judicial Service and the Gauhati High Court of Judicature.
- (e) When an officiating appointment is to be made by direct recruitment to a permanent post, if it is necessary in the Public interest that the appointment should be made immediately and a reference to the Commission would cause undue delay :

Provided that, if the vacancy, actual or probable, is for a period of six months or more, the Commission shall, as soon as possible, be consulted in all matters mentioned in clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution but not later than the 30th day from the date of issue of such appointment orders.

- (f) When an appointment is to be made by direct recruitment to a temporary post, if it is necessary in the public interest that the appointment should be made immediately and a reference to the Commission would cause undue delay :

Provided that if the temporary post has been sanctioned or, is likely to last more than six months, the Commission shall, as soon as possible, be consulted in all matters mentioned in clause (3) of the Article 320 of the Constitution but not later than the 30th day from date of issue of such appointment orders.

- (g) When it is proposed to re-appoint a retired servant of the Government of India or State Government temporarily to (i) a permanent post created in addition to the Cadre of the service from which he retired or (ii) a temporary post created as addition to the Cadre of the service from which he retired or (iii) any other temporary post the duties of which are similar to those normally discharged by members of that service:
- (h) When it is proposed to appoint temporarily an Officer of the Indian Armed

Forces to a Civil post or service for a period not exceeding three years;

- (i) When it is proposed to make appointment to a post on a contract basis for a period not exceeding three years;

Provided that in case the appointment on a contract basis is likely to exceed a period of three years, the Commission shall be consulted before the contract is renewed or extended;

- (j) When it is proposed to make any appointment to an honorary post.

Limitation of functions in respect of promotion 4.

It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission on the principles to be followed in making promotions or on the suitability of candidates for promotion in the following cases:-

- (a) Promotion to a service by an authority other than the Governor;
- (b) Promotion from a lower to a higher grade or post within the time scale of pay provided in the Rules unless the promotion is to be made by selection;
- (c) Officiating promotion for a period which is not likely to last for more than one year;

Provided that if the period of officiating promotion is extended beyond the term for which it was originally sanctioned, the period of promotion shall, for purpose of this regulation, be reckoned from the date when the promotion originally took effect and not from the date of the extension of the period.

Limitation of functions in respect of transfer 5.

It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission on the principles to be followed in making transfer or on the suitability of candidates for transfer from one post to another in the same service.

Limitation of functions in respect of disciplinary cases 6.

It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be of consulted in disciplinary matters in the following cases :-

- (a) in passing an order by any authority other than Governor, whether the order passed is an original, an appellate or a revisionary order;
- (b) by the Governor, when rejecting a petition or memorial;
- (c) in any case in which the Commission has at any previous stage been consulted as to the order to be passed and no fresh question has thereafter arisen for determination.

ILLUSTRATIONS

- (a) The stoppage of an officer appointed by the Governor at an efficiency bar does not require consultation with the Commission.
- (b) an officer is censured by the Governor. It is not necessary to consult Commission before the order of censure is passed;
- (c) an officer is suspended pending an enquiry into his conduct. The Commission need not be consulted before the order of suspension is passed;
- (d) it is proposed to dismiss a State Service Officer or to reduce his pension. The Commission must be consulted before an order is passed by the Governor;
- (e) It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission in any case relating to:
 - (i) the termination of probation of any person;
 - (ii) the discharge of reversion of a person otherwise than as penalty;
 - (iii) the termination of the employment of a person in accordance with the terms of his contract or employment;
 - (iv) the imposition of any penalty laid down in any rule or order for failure to pass any test or examination within a specified time;
- (f) Reduction in pension in a disciplinary case. The pension of an official is reduced by the Head of Department. The appeal is filled before the Governor. The Commission should be consulted before the appeal is disposed of by Governor;
- (g) An Assistant in a District Office is dismissed by the District Officer. He appeals to the Governor. The Commission will be consulted before an order is passed by the Governor.
- (h) An official in a subordinate service is dismissed by the Head of Department. An appeal made to the Governor. It is not necessary for the Head of Department to consult the Commission before

dismissing the official. But the Commission should be consulted by the Governor before deciding the appeal;

- (i) An Officer who was dismissed by an original order of the Governor memorializes the Governor against that order. The Commission need not be consulted on the memorial if the order of dismissal was after consulting the Commission.
 - (j) An official was dismissed on his appeal rejected by an authority Subordinate to the Governor. He memorializes the Governor against that order. The Commission must be consulted before the Governor re-instates him but not if the Governor decides to reject his memorial.
7. All previous Regulation made on the subject shall stand repealed on and from the date of the commencement of this Regulation;

Provided that any action or actions taken under such Regulations hereby repealed shall be deemed to have been taken under these Regulations.
