- 2. Discuss the different types of psychological tests. Elucidate the different requirements in the construction of psychological tests. (10+10=20)
- 3. Discuss the causal factors that contribute to the development of mental disorders. Provide examples to illustrate your points. (10+10=20)
- 4. What is rehabilitation psychology? Explain the role of a psychologist in the rehabilitation of persons suffering from substance abuse. (5+15=20)

- (a) Explain the impact of distance learning through IT and mass media.
- (b) Examine specific examples of psychological strategies used in historical or contemporary conflicts, highlighting their effectiveness or consequences.
- (c) Describe the factors necessary for the motivation and training of individuals for entrepreneurship and economic development.
- (d) Elaborate on the scope and importance of psychological interventions for the improvement in the performance of sportsmen.
- 6. What is meant by disadvantaged groups? What are the consequences of belonging to a disadvantaged group? (5+15=20)
- 7. Describe the manifestation of prejudice between the in-group and out-group highlighting the causes of such prejudice. (20)
- 8. What is counselling psychology? Examine the role of counselling psychology in various contexts such as group counselling, family and marital counselling for the socially disadvantaged individuals.
