15.	15. Fill in the blanks. $(10 \times 1=10)$		
	(a)	There are different kinds of Travelling Allowances in the Supplementary Rules	
	(b)	Daily allowance can be drawn in full if the duration of absence from headquarters is more than hrs.	
	(c)	A/an is an allowance calculated on the distance travelled which is given to meet the cost of a particular journey.	
	(d)	Daily allowance may not be drawn for any day on which a Government servant does not reach a point outside a radius of kms from the duty point.	
	(e)	Where no specific rates have been prescribed by the concerned authority the rate of mileage allowance for journey performed in own car will be ` per km.	
	(f)	Government servants in the Pay Level and above are entitled to air travel on tour or training within the country.	
	(g)	No Daily Allowance shall be drawn for the period beyond days while on temporary duty or training.	
	(h)	A Government servant in Pay Level 12 is permitted to reimburse up to ` for hotel accommodation per day.	
	(i)	A composite transfer grant which is equal to of the last month's basic pay may be granted to a Government servant for journey on transfer.

 - (a) Permanent Travelling Allowance may be drawn all the year round irrespective of whether the Government servant is absent from his headquarters or not.
 - (b) Daily Allowance will not be drawn while on transit but is admissible only from the date on which the Government servant actually performs the task for which he is on tour / training.
 - (c) Daily Allowance is not admissible for Saturday and Sunday even if the Government servant is required to be away from the headquarters on these days.
 - (d) Transfer TA is not admissible if the transfer is made at own request.
 - (e) A retiring Government servant is entitled to Transfer TA from the last station of his duty to home town or to the place where he is to settle down permanently on the conditions as laid down by the Rules.

- (a) Pu Lala, LDC died in Shillong while on official tour and his body was brought home in a commercial flight at Government's expense.
- (b) Pu Hnema, an Under Secretary on tour to Kolkata had to extend his stay for an additional three days on account of cancellation of flight. He submitted DA claim for the three days.
- (c) A Government servant was on tour for ten days and took casual leave for two days while on tour. He submitted DA claims for the ten days.
- (d) A Government servant on transfer from one station to another had travelled in his own car. He claimed road mileage for self in addition to the cost transportation of the car.
- (e) A family of a deceased Government servant claimed travelling allowance for journey from the Government servant's headquarters to their home town.
